Zedroom & Zathroom


Featuring a luxurious king-sized bed, and a private bathroom ensuite on the first floor it's a light room with two windows which enjoys the morning sun.



1 Minute Walk from the Cottage !!!





We know that pets are family. Teddy the Schnauzer is here to help with the guidelines:


Pet Etiquette: We can only accommodate one small dog at a time so please contact us in advance if you want to bring your pet with you.

DIRECTIONS

- 1. From the south via Derby head north on the A6 through Duffield or from the north, head south on the A6 through Belper
- 2.On entering Milford , turn left on to Chevin Road and first left on to Sunny Hill
- 3. The cottage is located 150 yards up the hill on the right hand side.

Additional notes: Check in time is any time after 3pm. Please message or communicate with us if you are going to arrive earlier and we may be able to accommodate you. There is free parking on the road immediately outside.

Check out is prior to 10am. We do our best to accommodate late checkouts, so please get in touch with us if you need that. We can only accommodate depending on availability.

We expect the cottage to be left as you found it so please wash up and remove your rubbish on departure. Black bin is for recycling and green bin for general waste (both located in the courtyard, marked 'No. 22')
